Recipe of the Month - Turmeric-Laced Prawns

INGREDIENTS

1 lb. prawns peeled and deveined
2 tbsp. ginger, chopped
2 cloves garlic, crushed
1/4 diced tomato
1 tsp. ground turmeric
1/2 cup unsweetened coconut milk
Chopped cilantro
1/2 lime
2 kaffir leaves



DIRECTIONS

Sauté prawns over high heat until they just turn pink. Add ginger and garlic. Stir. Add turmeric, diced tomatoes, coconut milk, cilantro and kaffir leaves.

Bring liquid up just under a simmer. Adjust seasonings to taste. Squeeze the lime over the prawns.

Serve over steamed jasmine rice and ENJOY!!!
